BACKGROUND : SHARE International was founded in 2010 as a non-profit charity registered under IRS penal code 501 (3) (c) . Its primary mission is to empower the underserved by giving support for education. It also provides from time to time disaster relief in times of need.

It operates overseas through its affiliates . SHARE Pakistan is currently serving the children and youth by providing tuition assistance for schooling and other related services.

SHARE International through SHARE Pakistan, served in the following areas:

- 1. Syeda Sakina Education Fund
- 2. School Assistance Project.
- 3. Centers for Excellence.
- 4. Ramadan Service.
- 5. Memorial Scholarship Fund.
- 6. Disaster Relief.
- 7. Family Support Services.

Syeda Sakina Education Fund (SEF): SEF (est. January 2011), provides school fees and/or uniform/books and (other school related expenses) for children under 15 years of age. As of December 31st 2013, 350 students are enrolled in this program. First preference is given to orphans in this program. A child must maintain grade B or higher to maintain his enrollment in SEF. Number of students supported: 350

Amount disbursed on uniform, books, tuition: Rs 1528566.00

- School Assistance project: This project Schools and orphanages all over Pakistan were provided assistance in fulfilling their needs, of teachers' salaries, boarding and lodging for orphans and non-orphans students. The institutions which were supported include :
 - Al Mustafa public school, Quetta
 - Al Hassan public school, Jamshoro
 - Al Mustafa school, Rawalpindi
 - Al Qaim school, Taxilla
 - Al Kawther orphanage, Parachinaar
 - The City of Knowledge, Korangi Karachi

Any non profit school can apply for grant through SHARE International's website. Main eligibility criteria is the school must be serving the underserved and in line with SHAREs mission. Every institution is required to file a quarterly report with SHARE Pakistan, in order to maintain its grant. The School must continue to improve on key quality measures.

Number of Schools: 6

Amount disbursed: Rs 5667631.00

3. Center for Excellences:

These are after school tuition centers founded to support aspiring students in pursuing excellence. The centers provide extra curricular activities as well, such as sports (Sh Saeed Haider).

Two centers were established in Pakistan:

A. Sh. Saeed Haider Center for Excellence and gymnasium in Ahsanabad, Karachi.

B. Sh. Sibt e Jaffer Center for Excellence in F. B. Area, Karachi.

Number of Centers: 2

Amount disbursed: Rs 2203257.00

4. Ramadan Service :

432 families were provided with one month worth of food items. Rs 1436967.00 were spent in 15 towns scattered across Pakistan.

5. Scholarship Fund:

Under this fund, scholarship is awarded to bright, deserving students who are not covered under Syeda Sakina Fund. These are usually, youngsters who are in Intermediate grade or higher. Rs 162238.00 were disbursed under this heading to 5 students.


6. Disaster Relief :


Humanitarian crises destroy communities. SHARE Pakistan did provide social relief working through other local relief agencies at the time of Quetta disaster and Abbas Town Disaster (March 2013). Rs 18087901.00 were distributed towards, short term relief, like providing temporary shelter, clothing, and food for people affected. Similarly the funds were used for education purpose for children affected by the disaster.

7. Family Support Services :

SHARE Pakistan also provides social services to families that have lost their breadwinner. These funds are used for relief measures, such as housing rent, food, and other services that help a family live independently. Rs 1853658.00 were spent towards this effort.


